

# Public Hearing Notice

To all interested citizens of Campbellsville, Kentucky:

The Kentucky Department for Local Government is accepting application material for Community Development Block Grant CARES Act (CDBG-CV) funding. The City of Campbellsville intends to apply for funding for The Healing Place of Campbellsville to prepare for, prevent, and respond to the novel coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).

The City will hold a public hearing prior to the submission of the application form. The public hearing will be held on December 7, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. local time by way of Zoom. The purpose of this hearing is to obtain views on housing and community development needs, review proposed activities, review the proposed application, and solicit public comments. Technical assistance is available to help groups representing low and moderate-income persons in developing proposals.

- Amount of funds available and range of activities that may be undertaken.

- Plans for minimizing displacement of persons as a result of activities associated with CDBG funds and plans for providing assistance to those persons to be actually displaced as a result of CDBG-funded activities.
- Records regarding the past use of CDBG funds.
- A summary of other important program requirements.
